



2009 Harley-Davidson Motorcycle Raffle

1. Members of the KTBA Bike Draw Committee are not eligible to purchase tickets.
2. All raffle winners have one year from the date of the draw to claim their prize. If the winner can not be located after one year from the draw date, the Kingston Thunder Baseball Association will contact the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario. The bike will be sold and the funds donated back to the Kingston Thunder Baseball Association, if approved by the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario.
3. Prizes must be accepted as drawn. Cash equivalencies will not be allowed.
4. Ticket sales are restricted to the province of Ontario.
5. Prizes won by deceased persons will be awarded to their estates.
6. Tickets cannot be purchased by anyone under 18 years of age. Sellers must advise purchasers not to enter the name(s) of persons under 18 years of age on the tickets.
7. Prizes won by minors will be null and void and be returned to the draw.
8. Draw to be held on Saturday August 22nd, 2009 at 2:00pm. Location of draw to be at MotoSport Plus, 295 Dalton Avenue, Kingston, Ontario.
9. Draw Procedure: Three tickets will be drawn by a member of the KTBA Bike Draw committee or an agent appointed to do so by the Committee, commencing no earlier than 2:00pm on Saturday August 22, 2009. Tickets will be drawn in reverse order, third prize first, then second prize followed by the grand prize. Tickets drawn for secondary prizes will be returned to the prize barrel following each draw so that all tickets are eligible for the grand prize draw. All Participants are eligible to win more than one prize during the draws.
10. Contest runs from January 23, 2009 to August 22, 2009.
11. Tickets have no cash value and refunds are not available.
12. Tickets may be purchased by more than one person, however In the event a winning ticket stub has more than one name on it, the licensed charity shall award the prize to the individual who's name appears first on the ticket, and the licensee or their agents are not responsible for any disputes which may arise between the different individuals whose names appear on the ticket stub.

13. All winners are required to produce Two (2) acceptable forms of identification proving their name and address to match the ticket stub drawn and sign an acceptance form before taking a prize into their possession. Identification must include a minimum of one piece of picture ID, (ie. Valid Ontario Driver's License).
14. After a winner has accepted a prize the Kingston Thunder Baseball Association and the suppliers of the prize(s) are not responsible for any fees, maintenance costs, taxes, or insurance related to the use of that prize.
15. Prize winners will be contacted by telephone, and/or email, and/or registered mail.
